

BIRD NOTES

Mountain Ducks and Other Birds at Currency Creek.—Between March 1 and 7, about 500 Mountain Ducks were seen feeding on peas after destroying ten acres of barley. Black Ducks came up the creek in large numbers at sunset every evening. Other birds seen were Stubble Quail in numbers, Eastern Swamp Hens, 2 Widgeon, 3 Grey Teal, Cape Barren Geese, Black Swans, Blue Herons, Brown Bittern, White Ibis, Spur-winged Plovers, Red-capped Dotterels, Pied Cormorants, Silver Gulls, Fairy and Caspian Terns, Wedge-tailed Eagles, Swamp Harriers, Nankeen Kestrel, and White-fronted Chats.—O.
