

BIRD NOTES

Fleshy-footed Shearwater (*Puffinus carneipes*).—Specimen picked up between Victor Harbour and Port Elliot in January, 1946. Skeleton now in Museum, No. B23599. Attached to the feathers of the neck were a number of the larvae of the Case-bearing Clothes-Moth (*Tinca pallionella*). The place where the dead bird was picked up was at least a quarter of a mile from the nearest human habitation.—J. B. Cleland.
