

**BIRD NOTES**

White-capped Albatross (*Diomedea cauta*).  
—A mummified specimen was found in January at Encounter Bay. Skeleton now in S.A. Museum, No. B23598. Previous specimens (skeletal material) from South Australia and now in the Museum are from Goolwa (April, 1924) and Encounter Bay (January, 1925, and January, 1931).—Miss Joan Cleland.
