

### BIRDS OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Following the latest report of the Checklist Committee (No. 4) (*vide* "Emu," 46, 1, 70), the following changes should be made to the List of Birds of South Australia (published in this journal, volume 18, part 2).

No. 40 *Pterodroma lessoni*, White-headed Petrel becomes *Pterodroma lessonii*; No. 67 *Sterna dougalli*, Roseate Tern becomes *Sterna dougallii*; No. 108 *Capella hardwicki*, Australian Snipe becomes *Capella hardwickii*; No. 157 *Elanus axillaris*, Black-shouldered Kite becomes *Elanus notatus*; No. 175 *Calyptorhynchus banksi* becomes *Calyptorhynchus banksii*; No. 198 *Neophema bourki*, Bourke Parrot becomes *Neophema*

*bourkii*; No. 281 *Acanthiza hamiltoni*, Red-tailed Thornbill is included under No. 280 *Acanthiza pusilla*, Brown Thornbill; No. 284 *Acanthiza morgani*, Slender Thornbill and No. 285 *Acanthiza hedleyi*, Dark Thornbill are combined as No. 283a *Acanthiza iredalei*, Dark Thornbill.

Total number of species for South Australia 384.

Also insert No. 338a *Myzomela nigra*, Black Honeyeater which was inadvertently omitted in the original draft of the above-mentioned List of the Birds of South Australia.—H. T. Condon.
