

### ADDITIONS AND CORRECTIONS TO A LIST OF BIRDS OF THE NORTHERN TERRITORY

The following corrections refer to a list published in the "South Australian Naturalist," volume 23, No. 1, pp. 8-10 (1943). Printers' omissions to be inserted:

*Charadrius mongolus*—Mongolian Sand Dotterel (4 records).

*Erolia testacea*—Curlew Sandpiper (many records).

*Cacomantis flabelliformis* — Fan-tailed Cuckoo (Alice Springs, by Winnecke).

*Ashbyia lovensis*—Gibber Bird (vicinity Charlotte Waters).

*Malurus amabilis*—Lovely Wren (several records).

*Myzomela nigra*—Black Honeyeater (records by North and Mules, at Coniston).

*Corvus bennetti*—Little Crow (several records and specimens).

*Epthianura albifrons*—White-fronted Chat (Macdonald Downs, by Cleland).

The following were recorded from Melville Island by Mathews (Ibis, 1914):

*Eulabeornis castaneiventris*—Chestnut Rail.

*Squatarola squatarola*—Grey Plover.

*Arenaria interpres*—Turnstone.

*Pluvialis dominicus*—Eastern Golden Plover.

*Crocethia alba*—Sanderling.

*Calidris canutus*—Knot.

*C. tenuirostris*—Great Knot.

The following have been reported since 1944:

*Capella hardwickii*—Australian Snipe (near Darwin, by Thomas).

*Neositta pileata*—Black-capped Sittella (Hermannsburg, by McGill).

The following are doubtful additions:

*Peltohyas australis*—Australian Dotterel (Red Lily Lagoon, by Sedgwick).

*Ninox strenua*—Powerful Owl (Darwin; Pt. Essington, by Ramsay, 1890).

*Dacelo gigas*—Kookaburra (MacArthur River, by Tindale).

*Climacteris picumnus*—Brown Treecreeper (at Birdum, by Thomas).

*Philemon corniculatus*—Noisy Friar Bird (Birdum, by Thomas, and Melville Bay, by Humphries).

Delete:

*Phaps elegans*; *Phalacrocorax fuscescens*;  
*Platycercus adscitus*; *Colluricincla harmonica*.
