Little Penguin (*Eudyptula minor*).—At Encounter Bay on the two hot evenings of January 27 and 28, 1951, and on previous still nights, Penguins on Wright Island could be heard making considerable noise in bursts after intervals of silence. The noise made was hard to describe, but seemed to be a combination of guttural whistles and trilling noises somewhat suggestive of that made by crickets.—J. B. Cleland.
