

FLORA AND FAUNA RESERVES

RESUMPTION.

It has been announced (*G.G.*, March 31, 1960) that flora and fauna reserves on Eyre Peninsula (Hundred of Hincks and Section 19 Hundred of Murlong) which were proclaimed in December, 1957, are now resumed.

DEDICATION

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has proclaimed Section 2, Hundred of Hincks, and Section 25, Hundred of Murlong, as flora and fauna reserves, to be "under the care, control and management of the Flora and Fauna Committee" (*G.G.*, March 31, 1960). These areas, which are Crown Lands, are exclusive of all necessary roads. They are described as "the greater portion of the land" which has been resumed.
