

## SPINE-TAILED SWIFTS

On January 19, 1961, approximately 50 Spine-tailed Swifts (*Apus caudacutus*) were observed flying from south to north over the Adelaide suburb of Clarence Gardens between 7.15 p.m. and 7.30 p.m. The weather was humid, with a thunderstorm approaching from the north-east; the temperature at the time was 92 deg.

Some birds were noticed circling appearing to be resting on the wing.
