

SCARLET ROBIN ON YORKE PENINSULA

Following the discussion at the June meeting of the Association on the question of the occurrence of the Scarlet Robin (*Petroica multicolor*) on Yorke Peninsula, South Australia, I have consulted my field notes and find that when I visited Pondalowie Bay on September 4, 1960, a male of this species was observed in a teatree swamp by myself, my daughter Rosemary, and sister Mrs. L. Heathcote.

So far as known, this is the first record of the Scarlet Robin on the southern end of the Peninsula, although it has been recorded from the northern portion by H. T. Condon (*S. Austr. Orn.*, 21, p. 59. 1955).—Mrs. M. Daley, Clarence Park.
