

A WILD LITTLE CORELLA X GALAH
HYBRID

Of a presumed pair of Little Corellas (*Kakatoë sanguinea*) which appeared at the homestead, Erdora Farm, east of Sutherlands, S.A., on August 29, 1957, one was a grey variant or hybrid. It was grey on the upper parts and mottled grey on the ventral surface. The face and head were soiled white, and there was no trace of pink on the forehead. The bare area surrounding the eyes was clearly defined, and there was some yellow on the tail-feathers.

Both birds were remarkably tame, and they were possibly escapees from an aviary. Or were they deliberately released in the district for the purpose of misleading the local amateur?
