131. Eastern Curlew—I.C.I. salt pans (AP), One on Aug 17; Port Gawler (AP), 21 on Sept. 13 (G. Clarke).

203. Orange-bellied Parrot—reported from the South-East by a reliable observer.

234. Horsefield Bushlark—north - west of Waterloo Corner (AP), one on Sept. 7 (G. Clarke).

375. Apostle-Bird—near Blanchetown (MM) Nov. 11 (W. Head).
