

**EXTENSION OF THE MOUNTAIN
DUCK'S RANGE**

I observed six Mountain Ducks at Parry's Lagoon, approximately sixteen miles south-east of Wyndham, in Western Australia, on 21st May, 1970. One bird was unable to fly and, when caught, was found to be heavily in moult. H. J. Frith, in *Waterfowl in Australia* (p. 143), gives the Mountain Duck's range as north to Cape Leveque; so this record extends the range of vagrant Mountain Ducks by about 350 miles to the north-east in W.A.
