

CITATION: ERHARD FRANZ BOEHM

At the Annual General Meeting on 18 April 1980, Erhard Boehm was elected an Honorary Member of the South Australian Ornithological Association.

Erhard's contributions to ornithology in South Australia have been many and varied. His research interests have spanned the fields of bird behaviour, anatomy, movements and nidification, but he is probably best known for his extensive documentation of the avifauna of the Mount Mary Plains-Morgan region where he lived until his recent retirement to Adelaide.

Erhard's sincere interest in conservation was reflected in perceptive papers published in this Journal in 1955 and 1959, papers which should be read by all serious conservationists in this State. His first contribution to this Journal appeared in 1928 but the results of many of his long-term banding projects in the Mt Mary Plains region have appeared more recently in *The Australian Bird Bander*, Vols 12 and 14, and in *Corella*, Vols. 1 and 2.

The Association wishes Erhard a happy retirement.
