Table 1, page 58: in the line for Grey Falcon add 'P' (for Present) in column 4 (≥ 1946).

Discussion, page 62 third paragraph, change second sentence to two sentences: 'These include the Grey Falcon, which is represented only by a SAMA specimen collected in 1890 at Fulham and by a single bird seen at Novar Gardens by John Turner on 10/9/2006 (accepted by Birds SA Rare Bird Committee, *South Australian Ornithologist* 45: 12-22). In addition, a pair attempted to nest at Grange GC ...'

Bird species showing increases over the 1988-2020 period:

Page 75 last paragraph, second sentence: add 'Rainbow Lorikeet' after 'Long-billed Corella'.

Page 77, insert between second and third paragraphs: 'Survey records from the Kooyonga and Glenelg GCs 1990-2020 show a marked increase in numbers of Rainbow Lorikeet. At Kooyonga in the 1990s an average of 30 birds were seen, with most flying over, while by 2011-2020, an average of 100-150 birds were seen, with between half and two-thirds flying over. At Glenelg GC an average of about 10 birds per survey was recorded in the 1990s, increasing to 30-50 birds per survey in 2011-2020; on most visits the majority of birds were flying over.'
