

From Mr. E. Ashby, of Blackwood, in the Mount Lofty Ranges—"On June 11, my son (A. K. Ashby) identified Swift Lorikeet (*Lathamus discolor*) flying over at Blackwood; 6th, three of these birds flying over garden, and later one seen in the flowering blue gums near the house. Same date, Regent Honey-eaters (*Zanthoniza phrygia tregellasi*) calling freely. 20th, saw a score of Red-rumped Parrots (*Psephotus haematonotus*) in one flock just outside my property; Adelaide Rosellas (*P. e. adelaidae*) numerous, and Blue-bellied Lorikeets (*Trichoglossus novae-hollandiae*; still about. 24th—This evening the Stone Plover (*Burhinus magnirostris*) was calling; have not heard them for a long time previously."
