

From Capt. S. A. White, on the Adelaide plains, at the Reedbeds, June 2—Spiny-cheeked Honey-eaters (*Acanthagenys rufogularis*) calling; also heard the first Fantail Cuckoo (*C. rubricatus*). 20th—Spiny-cheeked Honey-eaters calling. Several Fantailed Cuckoos about, Scarlet-breasted Robin in the garden, numbers of Magpie Larks (*Grallina cyanoleuca*) flying over during the day. Brown Flycatchers (*Microeca fascinans*) singing sweetly all day. 25th—Several Swans (*C. atrata*) on the water in the swamps; both Teal and Black Duck plentiful.
