Willie Wagtail, with three young, seen for the first fortnight in October in the garden, the young being fed by both young parent birds.

October 23—In the rain about 5 p.m., a male and female Scarlet-breasted Robin were seen, after a lapse of some months.

October 28th and 29th--Black-chinned Honey-eater heard calling.

The Fairy Martins noted building in a small dry, watercourse, finally left on October 2nd, after the nests had been broken down four times by boys between the 26th of September and October 2nd.
