## An Enumeration of the Birds between Port Augusta and Clare.

During an excursion along the East-West Line in August, 1922, we were enabled, through the courtesy and kindness of Dr. Gorrie, of Port Augusta, to make some excursions from Port Augusta to the adjacent parts of the Flinders Range by car, and also to travel from Port Augusta to Clare. A tally was kept of the numbers of individual birds seen on these trips. The distance travelled was about 205 miles, so that by halving the numbers of the birds seen one will get an approximate idea of the number of each kind that one may expect to see whilst travelling 100 miles over these roads by motor car. Thus one could expect to see more than 100 Magpies, or about one to each mile, 17 or 18 Ground-Larks, about ten Magpie-Larks, 11 Hawks, 33 Red-backed Parrots, 24 Welcome Swallows, or 42 Swallows of all kinds, 22 Willie-Wagtails, 22 White-fronted Chats, and 17 or 18 Song-Larks.

The following are the details of the journeys:-- .

1. August 30th, Port Augusta to Pichi-Richi Pass to Quorn to Wilmington to Horrock's Pass to Port Augusta, 75 miles. Saltbush flats for about ten miles, then trees in gorge, then open country with occasional trees, then through a pass with trees again, and finally 20 miles over a saltbush plain. Sunny; cool.

2. August 31st, Port Augusta to Port Germein, 42 miles. Saltbush, with occasional belts of lew timber. Sunny; cool;

morning.

3. Port Germein to Clare, 88 miles. Six miles of saltbush, then through the Gerge with trees, then mostly cleared country, with occasional trees. Sunny; cool; afternoon.
