Visitors during this month were:—Narrow-billed Bronze Cuckoo—Calling on 4th at 5.30 a.m., on 5th at 6.10 p.m., on 7th, on 8th at 5.20 a.m., and heard for the last time on 9th. Nankeen Kestrel—One bird seen on 7th. Spinebill—A bird seen on 13th and again on 14th. Magpie-Lark—Heard on 12th, 13th, and 14th. Curlew (Stone Plover)—Heard at 10.10 p.m. on 16th. This call is rarely heard nowadays. Delicate Owl—One bird seen about 8.30 p.m. on 30th. Purple-crowned Lorikeets—Small parties passed over daily. Willie-Wagtail—The last time I heard these birds singing during the night was on 26th. On 31st a parent bird with a young bird was in the garden. Noisy Miners—Young birds were seen during the month.
