Mistletoe-Bird.—On 7th March, at 1.10 p.m., I noticed a bird of this species eating the ripe berries on a *Coprosma* hedge next the path on Fullarton Road, Netherby. At the same time a Scarlet-breasted Robin was calling at a little distance away. The Mistletoe-Bird was heard on 9th and 10th. Spinebill.—Heard on 9th for the last time. Crimson Rosella.—A flock of seven were seen on 10th and a full-plumaged male in Dr. Pulleine's garden on 30th. Red-backed Parrot.—Noted on 10th and 28th. Delicate Owl.—Heard on 11th, 19th, and 20th. Boobook.—Heard on 12th, 24th, 25th, and 30th. Pardalote (most probably Spotted).—Heard twice on 25th. Laughing Kookaburra.—The young bird was still practising singing (?) on 21st.
