Black-faced Cuckoo-Shrike.—Noted on 3rd, 16th, 20th, 22nd, 24th, and 26th April. Boobook.—Heard on 3rd, 6th, and

15th. Delicate Owl.—Heard on 12th. Pardalote (Spotted ?).—Heard twice on 4th and once on 6th. Red-backed Parrot.—Noted on 6th and 11th. Crimson Rosella.—Noted on 7th, 9th, 15th, 18th, 27th, and 29th. Scarlet Robin.—Heard on 11th and 14th. Fairy Martin.—A flock of eight were seen on 10th. Peaceful Dove.—Heard on 7th, 16th, and 18th. Grey (White-shafted) Fantail.—A bird was seen on 18th and 24th. Noisy Miner.—A parent bird with three young, two of which seemed to be able to fend for themselves, was seen in the yard on 16th near to the birds' food table. The parent bird was noticed twice feeding one young one on 16th, and presumably the same two were there on 17th, the young bird being again fed by the parent. White-naped Honey-eater.—Noted on 11th, 13th, and 22nd.
