Scarlet Robin.—Heard on 4th and 20th May. White-faced Heron.—A pair was seen flying north-east at 5.30 p.m. on 7th. Whistler (sp. ?).—One was heard on 20th. Crimson Rosella.—A pair has been seen and heard all this month. Black-faced Cuckoo-Shrike.—Noted on 17th, 20th, 21st, 22nd, 26th, and 30th. White-plumed Honey-eater.—A young bird was heard in "Urrbrae" on 9th. Blackbird.—A young bird and the parents were about the garden from 21st to 28th. Spur-winged Plover.—The bird which was first noted in January is still here, and is frequently "chivvied" by the Magpies.
