

## Bird Notes.

The following 48 species were noted in the course of three very interesting outings in the Mt. Lofty Ranges at Ambleside and Bridgewater on 3rd and 17th November and 3rd December, 1924:—*Phaps chalcoptera* (Bronzewing), *Glossopsitta porphyrocephala* (Purple-crowned Lorikeet), *Platycercus elegans* (Crimson Rosella), *Psephotus haematonotus* (Red-backed Parrot), *Dacelo gigas* (Laughing Kookaburra), *Halcyon sanctus* (Sacred Kingfisher), *Cuculus pallidus* (Pallid Cuckoo), *Chalcites basalis* (Narrow-billed Bronze Cuckoo), *Lamprococcyx plagosus* (Bronze Cuckoo), *Hylochelidon nigricans* (Tree-Martin), *Microeca jascinans* (Jacky Winter), *Petroica multicolor* (Scarlet Robin), *Melanodryas cucullata* (Hooded Robin), *Rhipidura flabellifera* (Grey Fantail), *Rhipidura leucophrys* (Willie-Wagtail), *Seisura inquieta* (Restless Flycatcher), *Falcunculus frontatus* (Eastern Shrike-Tit), *Pachycephala pectoralis* (Golden Whistler), *Pachycephala rufiventris* (Rufous Whistler), *Colluricincla harmonica* (Grey Shrike-Thrush), *Graucalus novae-hollandiae* (Black-faced Cuckoo-Shrike), *Cinlosoma punctatum* (Spotted Ground-Bird),

*Lalage tricolor* (White-shouldered Caterpillar-eater), *Pomatorhinus superciliosus* (White-browed Babbler), *Oreocincla lunulata* (Australian Ground-Thrush), *Acanthiza pusilla* (Brown Thornbill), *Geobasileus reguloides* (Buff-tailed Thornbill), *Malurus cyaneus* (Blue Wren), *Artamus cyanopterus* (Dusky Wood-Swallow), *Climacteris picumna* (Brown Tree-creeper), *Climacteris leucophaea* (White-throated Tree-creeper), *Dicaeum hirundinaceum* (Mistletoe-Bird), *Pardalotus ornatus* (Red-tipped Pardalote), *Pardalotus punctatus* (Spotted Pardalote), *Melithreptus lunulatus* (White-naped Honey-eater), *Glyciphila melanops* (Tawny-crowned Honey-eater), *Acanthorhynchus tenuirostris* (Eastern Spinebill), *Zanthoniza phrygia* (Regent Honey-eater), *Melithreptus brevirostris* (Brown-headed Honey-eater), *Meliphaga penicillata* (White-plumed Honey-eater), *Meliornis pyrroptera* (Crescent Honey-eater), *Meliornis novae-hollandiae* (Yellow-winged Honey-eater), *Anthochaera carunculata* (Red Wattle-Bird), *Anthochaera chrysoptera* (Brush Wattle-Bird), *Zosterops lateralis* (Grey-backed Silver-eye), *Zonaeginthus guttatus* (Diamond Firetail), *Aegintha temporalis* (Red-browed Finch), *Gymnorhina hypoleuca* (White-backed Magpie).

Nests were seen of the Scarlet Robin, Willie-Wagtail, White-throated Tree-creeper (with young), and Eastern Shrike-Tit, and young birds were seen of the Hooded Robin, Grey Shrike-Thrush, Blue Wren, and White-naped Honey-eater.
