

Bird Notes.

Tenefeate Creek, near Onetree Hill.—On 19th April, 1925, a flock of about 30 Galahs (*Kakatoe roseicapilla*) were seen. On 26th April, 1925, 10 Choughs (*Corcorax melanorhamphus*) were seen at Kuitpo and an Azure Kingfisher (*Alcyon azurea*) on Blackfellow's Creek. On 3rd May, 1925, on Tenefeate Creek were noted a White Egret (*Egretta alba*) and four or five Galahs.

Buckland Park.—On 14th June, 1925, many Stubble Quail (*Coturnix pectoralis*) were seen. Also several Brown Song-Larks (*Cinclorhamphus cruralis*) were noted, some of whom were singing during the day. White-winged Wren (*Malurus leuconotus*), a male and several females, were seen.

Harrogate.—On 18th July, 1925, two male Flame Robins (*Petroica phoenicea*) were seen, a Fan-tailed Cuckoo (*Cacomantis flabelliformis*) was heard, and several Sulphur-crested Cockatoos (*Kakatoe galerita*) were noted.

Near Sellick's Hill.—On 22nd August, 1925, a male Flame Robin was seen, two White-backed Magpies (*Gymnorhina hypoleuca*) were nesting, and in the cases of the Yellow-tailed Thornbill (*Acanthiza chrysorrhous*) one nest was complete and another nest was being built.

On Friday, 28th August, 1925, a Reed Warbler (*Acrocephalus australis*) was heard singing in the reeds on the bank of the River Torrens near the bridge to the Oval.
