

### Some Notes re Kangaroo Island Birds.

*Squatarola squatarola*, Grey-Plover.—I collected a specimen, ♀, on the North Bay of Shoals, Kangaroo Island, on 27th September, 1923, from a flock of perhaps a dozen birds.

*Cereopsis novae-hollandiae*, Cape Barren Goose.—I saw one bird on a grassy flat at Stokes Bay in October, 1913, and was informed that the bird had been there for about two months prior to my visit. I never heard how long it remained there.

*Kakatoe roseicapilla*, Galah.—I saw one bird of this species amongst a flock of White (Sulphur-crested) Cockatoos (*Kakatoe galerita*) at Middle River in April, 1913, and was told that it had been seen about for three months prior to my visit.
