On a voyage to Kangaroo Island and back to Adelaide, 22nd and 25th July, 1926.

A Wandering Albatross (*Diomedea exulans*) was seen on 22nd and on 25th July in the Backstairs Passage. On 25th many Yellow-nosed Albatrosses (*D. chlororhyncha*) were seen, sometimes 12 were in sight at the one time; Giant Petrel (*Macronectes giganteus*), nine were sitting on the water just outside the Outer Harbour; Fluttering Shearwater (*Puffinus gavia*), about 50 were seen in Hog Bay; Australian Gannets (*Sula serrator*) were in great numbers about Hog Bay, and a number of Crested Terns (*Sterna bergii*) were there also.
